Organized in 1921 by Col. and Mrs.
Bullcock, Tannamondh Was
Planner in Middle
West.

At this time of the year, when
newspapers and magazines are full
of advertisements for summer camps,
South Bend may indeed be proud of
the fact that both boys and girls are
provided with easily accessible vaca-
tion facilities. The only camp main-
tained exclusively for girls in this
vicinity is Tannamondh, the prop-
erty of the South Bend Camp Fire
Girls, Pleasant Lake, Edwardsburg,
Mich.

Tannamondh, which was arranged
under the direction of Col. and Mrs.
C. S. Bullcock in 1921, was a pioneer
among girls' camps in the middle
west, and in its five years of opera-
tion has served over 1,000 girls,
many of whom expect to return this
year.

Originally the camp accommodated
about 20 girls. This season there is
ample room for 50 girls and the six
camp cottages, which, under the di-
rection of Miss Doris L. Bishop, form
the staff. This is Miss Bishop's
fourth season at the camp and she
has not only the training but ex-
perience to carry on the work effi-
ciently.

Site is Delightful.
The site of the camp on Pleasant
Lake is very delightful. The girls
have a good bathing beach, there are
no sink holes to make swimming
dangerous and this year a new fire
foot pier and life buoy are added to
the equipment. Miss Bishop, in-
structor at the University of Michigan, is
assistant instructor. Each year 25 in-
structors and the girls are taught
swimming and the girls are given
attention will be given beginners.

There are no questionable places of
amusement about the lake and the
cottages and residents of Edwards-
burg cooperate in many ways to
make the camp vacation pleasant
and safe. Much credit is due Mr.
Harwood, whose fine farm home
overlooks the camp, for allowing use
of his grounds for hikes and games.

The campers wear a uniform con-
sisting of middy, dark
blouses and dark shoes and stock-
ings. This not only adds to the pic-
turesqueness of the camp, but also
creates a feeling of democracy. There
can be no distinction in dress which
the girl is rich or poor. Her
camp standing depends entirely upon
her own ability and disposition.

Gift Camp Paper.
Each year added opportunities for
instruction are afforded, along the
lines of handcraft and nature study,
and for the girl who is interested
there is offered each period a chance to be
on the staff of the Tannamondh
Tattler, the camp paper.
