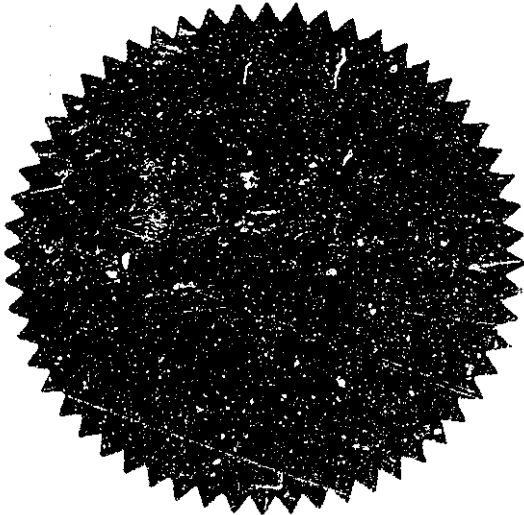
SOUTH BEND CAMP FIRE COUNCIL, INCORPORATED

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

(CERTIFICATE OF ORGANIZATION)

OF

South Bend Camp Fire Council, Incorporated

BE IT REMEMBERED, That there are hereby adopted the following articles of incorporation pursuant to the act of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana, approved March 6, 1889, Acts 1889, p. 141, entitled "An Act for the incorporation of societies not for pecuniary profit, defining their powers and providing for the election of directors, the dissolution of such corporations, distribution of their property, and the changing of their articles of association, and declaring an emergency."

1. The name or title by which this corporation shall be known in law is:

South Bend Camp Fire Council, Incorporated

2. The particular objects for which it is formed are: So far as possible, to carry into effect and perpetuate the program of Camp Fire Girls, Incorporated; to improve social life; to aid in the formation of habit making for health, usefulness, and the upbuilding of character to the end that work, health and love may be synonyms of womanhood; to own and operate camps and carry on camping and character building programs; to own land; to accept gifts of property both real and personal.

3. The number of directors of this corporation shall be 19 and the names of the directors selected for the management of its business and prudential concerns for the first year of its existence are:

George Lozier, Walter W. Borden, Winifred Ferguson, Rev. William A. Moloney, Clara Johnson, William Hass, Earl Davidson, Lawrence Harwood.
