

CAMP HOSPITAL TO BE DEDICATED

Tannadoonah Girls Being Presented Building Today.

A hospital donated to the South Bend council of Camp Fire Girls by the South Bend Kiwanis club will be dedicated at Camp Tannadoonah, on Birch lake, Vandalia, Mich., at 2:30 p. m. today.

The infirmary, to be known as the Kiwanis health center, was erected by members of the club to whom recognition will be given this afternoon. Dedicatory remarks will be given by R. E. Fleming. Howard Emmons will make the formal presentation. Plans for the building were made by Carl Nelson, with Mr. Emmons as chairman of the project. The committee assisting him included Robert D. Bonnell, Mr. Nelson, Dr. O. J. Grundy and Robert McLain.

The infirmary, which these last eight weeks has proved to be an outstanding improvement in the camp, is equipped with a four-bed ward, first aid or examination room, nurse's room and bathroom.

Saturday marked the opening of the eighth and final week of the camping season with 60 girls registered. The week's activities will be climaxed by a midnight banquet on Friday.
