**Stone Lake Session Opens Last Week On Sunday.**

At the close of the camping season for Mishawaka Camp Fire girls at Stone Lake, Lagrange county, Indiana, July 24 and 25, the 47th camp at Castle Manor will have had the privilege of life at a girls camp. Two hundred and eighty girls have participated in one of the camping programs so far, with 45 new campers checking in at Camp Mishawaka last Sunday for the first week.

Both camping programs have included many activities in handcraft, outdoor craft, sports and games, dramatics and music. Also important at Camp Mishawaka has been the religious activities program with many American Red Cross advertisements made under the instruction of Jack Moore, water safety instructor.
