

COOK WITHOUT PANS TONIGHT AT GIRLS CAMP

More than 20 members of the Camp Fire Girls' Guardians association and others interested in girls' leadership work will be at Camp Tannadoonah, Birch lake, near Vandalia, Mich., this evening for the first session of a fall leadership training course.

Outdoor cooking will be demonstrated by Miss Dorothy E. Brown, South Bend executive, in the camp craft area. Methods of cooking without the aid of utensils—including soft boiling an egg in wet paper and hot coals—will be shown.

After their training session the guardians will have an outdoor supper. Meetings of the course will continue on Wednesday evenings at headquarters in the Chamber of Commerce building. Subjects will include handcraft, girl psychology, first aid and health, business craft, nature lore, homecraft, songs and symbolism.
