

Camp Fire Girl Handicraft in Store Display

Headbands, wood blocks, ceremonial gowns, looms and other examples of Camp Fire girls handicraft were placed on exhibit Tuesday in a display window of the F. W. Woolworth company store, 109 Lincoln Way West. The articles are the work of local girls and several of the pieces are identified with the makers' names.

Featured in the exhibit is a group of articles made by Virginia Kaiser who recently won first place in a national hobby contest conducted by the Wonder World Activity club, Chicago, with her Camp Fire handicraft work. Shown are Virginia's ceremonial gown, loom, headband and count book.

Two other ceremonial gowns, belonging to Beulah Kaiser and Gwen Jacobs, also are on exhibit. Both leather and bead headbands are shown. Various types of looms for making the bead bands and several examples of wooden bead work are included in the display.
