

CAMP FIRE GIRLS ARRANGE OUTING

Baugo Creek Is Site for Three-Day Event.

Camp Fire Girls and Blue Birds will turn into outdoor girls for three days of next week when they attend a "day camp" Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday at Baugo creek, Osceola, this county. Plans for the camp were announced today by a committee headed by A. A. Brewer.

All regular camp activities except swimming will be incorporated in the three-day program. With Miss Wilma Rea as director and a registered nurse in charge at all times the camp will be conducted from 8 a. m. to 8 p. m. each day. Girls may attend for one, two or three days.

The committee announced that campers must take along enough food for the length of time they intend to stay, a signed note from their parents giving them permission to take part in all activities of the camp and bedding for outdoor sleeping. Each girl must provide her own transportation but luggage will be hauled from Camp Fire headquarters, 107½ Lincoln Way East, during the morning of each camp day.
